OVERVIEW:

This formal program articulation agreement is made and entered into by the Curators of the University of Missouri on behalf of the University of Missouri, Kansas City, hereinafter referred to as UMKC, and the Junior College District of Metropolitan Kansas City, Missouri, hereinafter referred to as MCC. By this agreement MCC and UMKC express a shared commitment to increasing opportunities for student access to and success in higher education. By clarifying transfer policies and procedures which assure articulation between programs, the institutions seek to assist students in making a seamless transfer from the associate to the baccalaureate degree.

PURPOSE:

This agreement provides students who have earned an **Associate in Arts** the opportunity to complete a **Bachelor of Arts or Science** at UMKC. Any Metropolitan Community College student who has earned an Associate in Arts is guaranteed that UMKC will accept designated freshman and sophomore major related credits and all freshman and sophomore general education credits and will meet requirements/prerequisites such to the Bachelor of Arts or Science degree in a manner consistent with the treatment of native students.

CONDITIONS OF TRANSFER:

Section I: Admissions and Matriculation

MCC students maintaining continuous enrollment under this agreement will be afforded the same treatment and protection as UMKC native students enrolled under a specific catalog.

MCC, upon request of students, will provide verification of completed courses to UMKC through its Office of Admissions and Records.

The transcript of students transferring from MCC will be evaluated by representatives from the College of Arts and Science and Registrar's Office at UMKC.

Transfer students from MCC will have access to financial aid, scholarships, and student services on the same basis as native students.

Minimum grade standards for academic progress and graduation from MCC will be subject to no further review by UMKC.

UMKC will apply the same academic progress and graduation standards to MCC transfer students as those applicable to native students at UMKC.

Section II: Transfer of Credit

Transfer students from MCC, upon acceptance into the designated program at UMKC, will have junior standing at UMKC.

Section III: Program Plan


Students falling under this program articulation agreement will be responsible for successfully completing the following requirements for each degree category as attached per appendix.

TERMS OF AGREEMENT:

This agreement is made and entered into in the academic year 2000-2001 and remains in force unless changed in writing by mutual agreement of both parties. The agreement may be amended at any time with the approval of both parties and is subject to regular review to assure currency with the respective degree requirements. Should either party desire to discontinue this agreement, advance notification of two years will be required.





UMKC Bachelor of Arts Degree-Administration of Justice

UMKC requires a total of 36 credit hours, including 18 required hours of CJC courses, 12 additional hours of CJC elective courses, and 6 hours of related non-CJC courses approved by the department. A maximum of 12 hours in transfer credits (an introductory course equivalent and 9 additional hours) will be accepted toward the major field requirements. In addition, at least 18 of the 36 credit hours must be taken at the 300/400 level from the Criminal Justice and Criminology program offerings at UMKC. Note: MCC lower level courses* used as equivalencies to UMKC upper level (Jr./ Sr.) course will not count toward the degree of 36 hours of Jr./Sr. credit.

Finally, BS majors must complete three semesters of calculus, one year of college-level physics, one year of either college German or Russian, and one "advanced course" in either Chemistry, Physics or mathematics. The total credit hours in laboratory courses must be at least thirteen (13). A 2.0 grade average in the approved departmental program is required, as is a grade of at least a C in any Chemistry course that is a pre-requisite to a subsequent course..
