

## Application Checklist

**Admission is competitive and based on space availability. Early applications get priority consideration for scholarships. Application must be complete for processing. Any blanks left will delay the admission decision.**

**Students applying for English as a Second Language (ESL) are required to send the following documents only:**

1. **A completed and signed application form.**
2. **Non-refundable application fee of \$50 USD.** Fee may be paid by check or money order (made payable to UMKC). Visa and MasterCard are also accepted. DO NOT send cash.
3. Original or certified copy of **financial statement** (amount varies, see [www.umkc.edu/isao/tuition\\_costs.htm](http://www.umkc.edu/isao/tuition_costs.htm)).

**Students applying for other Academic Programs must send the following:**

1. **A completed and signed application form.**
2. Please write an **autobiographical essay** about yourself, interests and future plans on a separate sheet of paper.
3. Official copies of **Academic Credentials** — with literal English translation. All academic work must be included, and a syllabus of coursework with English translation provided. If available on the Web, include URL address.

4. Official **TOEFL Score Report** — for all applicants for whom English is not their native language.
5. Original or certified copy of **financial statement** (Amount varies, see [www.umkc.edu/isao/tuition\\_costs.htm](http://www.umkc.edu/isao/tuition_costs.htm)).
6. Official Admission **Test Score Report (GRE/GMAT)** — required by certain graduate departments and schools.
7. **International Student Transfer Form** — for all applicants who are transferring from another U.S. institution. Include copies of I-20, DS-2019, I-94 and visa page. Please download the form from our Web site: [www.umkc.edu/isao/forms/transfer\\_form.doc](http://www.umkc.edu/isao/forms/transfer_form.doc).
8. **Nonrefundable application fee of \$50 USD.** Fee may be paid by check or money order (made payable to UMKC). Visa and MasterCard are also accepted. DO NOT send cash.
9. A copy of the **biographic information/photo page in your passport.**
10. Three **letters of recommendation** (if applicable).

Admission is competitive, selective and students are accepted on a space-available basis.

#### International Student Scholarships

**1.9 Million Dollars in Scholarships:** We are offering more than 1.9 million dollars in partial scholarships for international students. We hope to be able to offer you a partial scholarship to subsidize your university education in the U.S.

**Chancellor's Non-resident Award:** International students who apply early may qualify for the Chancellor's Non-Resident Award (CNR). The Chancellor's Non-resident Award is a renewable award which covers the difference between Missouri resident and non-resident fees.

It is highly recommended that you mail your application to us at least one month prior to the above deadlines. An early applicant has a much better chance of receiving a partial scholarship. Some departments may have earlier deadlines. Refer to the academic department Web site for specific deadlines. Please express mail your application as early as possible.
