Scholarship Opportunities

UMKC awards more than \$2 million to international students each year.

CNR Award and DICE Award

The Chancellor's Non-Resident (CNR) Award and the Dean's International Computing and Engineering (DICE) Award are renewable scholarships that waive a portion of non-resident fees (approximately \$8,000 - \$9,000* annually) for newly admitted international degree-seeking students.

CNR Award and DICE Award Eligibility

- Minimum 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Minimum TOEFL score of 550 paper-based, 213 computer-based, or 79 Internet-based. Or, minimum IELTS score of 6.0.
- F-1 or J-1 visa holder
- Must be nominated by the UMKC academic unit

New applicants meeting the minimum requirements are automatically recommended to the academic unit for scholarship consideration.

Community College Leadership Award

The Community College Leadership Award (CCLA) is a renewable scholarship recognizing international students who have demonstrated leadership roles at their community colleges. Awardees receive a non-resident fee waiver and an additional \$1,500, for a total value of more than \$10,000* per year. For more information, visit www.umkc.edu/isao.

Doctoral Fee Waiver

All doctoral students are automatically awarded a fee waiver for the non-resident portion of their tuition; a total savings of approximately \$8,000 - \$9,000* for the 2008-09 academic year.
