

President's Award for Research and Creativity

For a Sustained Recognized Record of Research and Creativity

Purpose

To honor a University of Missouri faculty member for a sustained nationally and internationally recognized record of research and/or creativity.

Award Amount

The award carries a stipend of \$15,000, less applicable taxes.

Eligibility

Nominees must be full-time, regular faculty members who have been employed by the University of Missouri for at least five years prior to September 1 of the current academic year. Each campus may submit one nomination.

Nomination Format

All nomination materials must be submitted electronically.

Nominations should include a **cover letter** summarizing the nominee's research and/or creative accomplishments, an **up-to-date curriculum vita**, and **other supporting evidence of nationally and internationally recognized research and/or creativity**. Campuses are asked to limit the number of **reference letters to no more than 15**. Please include a **list of the references** submitting supporting letters which indicates each reference's relationship to the nominee and include any information about each reference's qualifications, which may be helpful to the Committee. A **one-page personal statement** from the nominee stating his/her research and/or creative objectives is also required.

Submissions

Submit all nomination materials electronically via email to awards@umkc.edu. E-mail 'Subject' line must be "**President's Research/Creativity Nomination**" followed by nominee's **LAST, FIRST NAME**.

Preferred material submission format is one **Combined PDF Document** or **PDF Portfolio**.

Documents must be arranged in the following order (*all file names should include a reference to the document type and nominee's last name, for example "CV SMITH.pdf" or "Ref List SMITH.pdf"*):

- 1. Cover Letter of Nomination**
- 2. Other Supporting Evidence of Nationally and Internationally Recognized Research and/or Creativity**
- 3. Complete List of References Submitting Supporting Letters** (*including qualifications and relationship to nominee*)
- 4. Individual Reference Letters of Support** [maximum 15] (*in order as listed in #3*)
- 5. Nominee's Personal Statement of Entrepreneurial/Creative Objectives**
- 6. Nominee's Current CV**
