

Frequently Asked Questions Regarding ASM Services for Spring 2021

Can I still get help with Tutoring?

Yes – UMKC Tutoring is available online via Zoom supporting a variety of classes including math, biology, chemistry, criminal justice, economics, physics, Spanish, and French. Students can make appointments through [UMKC Connect \(Starfish\)](#) 7 days per week or by emailing umkctutoring@umkc.edu. Can I still attend SI Sessions?
