Current Model (2023)

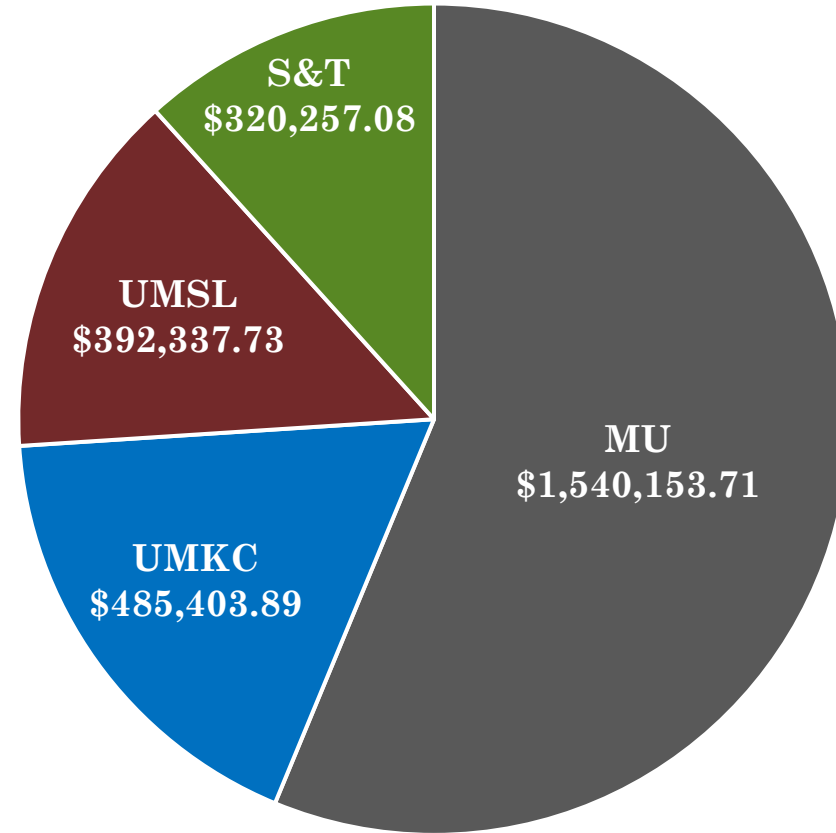
- System Funding Allocation to individual campuses
- Campuses place funding in account held at MU Libraries
- Budget managed by MU Libraries with all decisions subject to vote from all campuses

Budget and Distribution by Campus

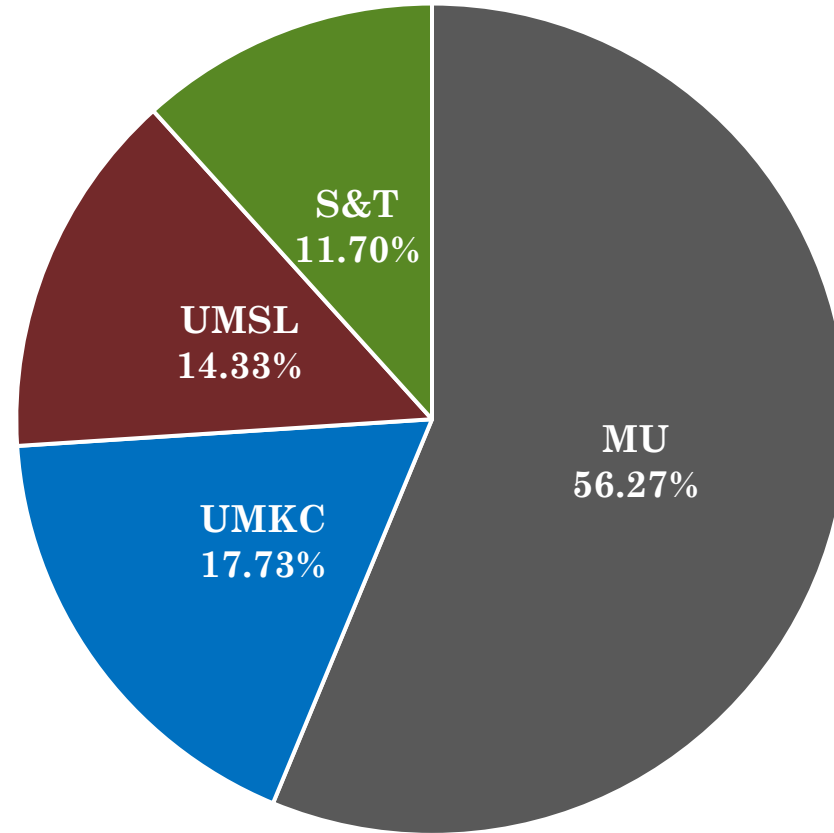

- MOBIUS – sharing collections across MO

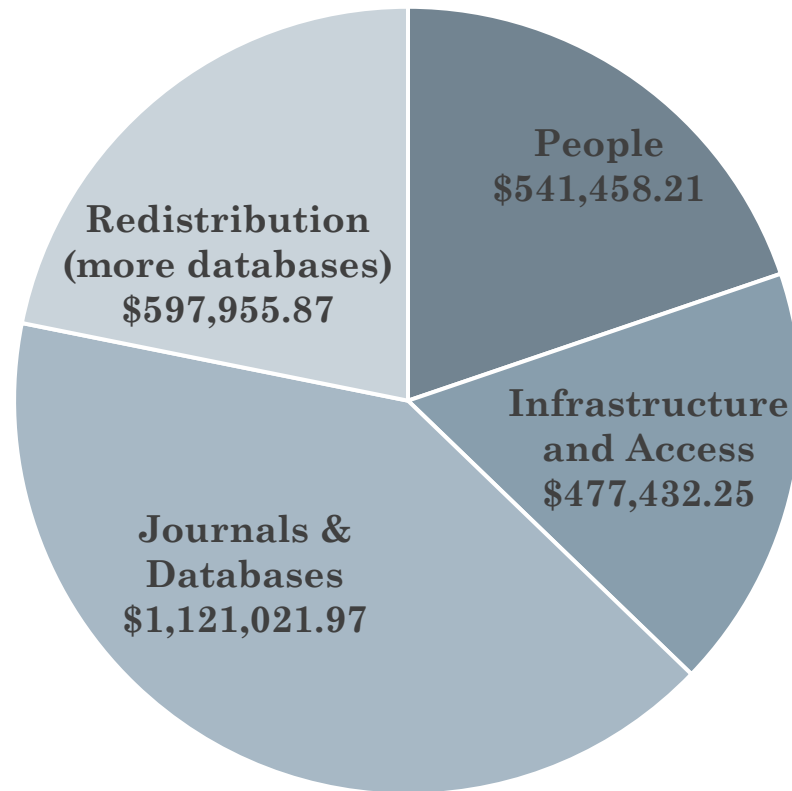
Journals/ Databases

Redistribution

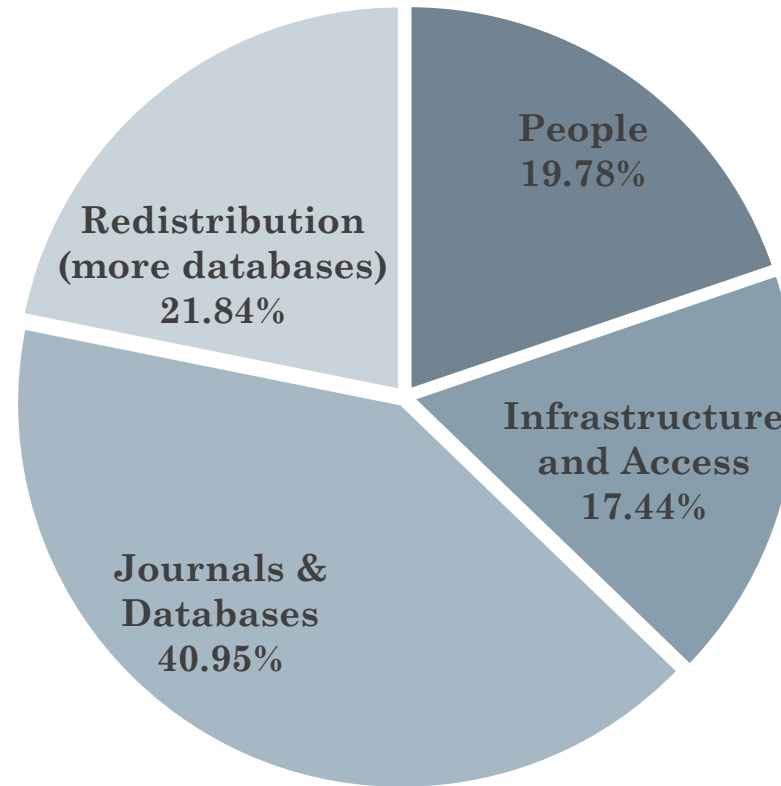
- Remaining funds – officially returned to campus libraries, but are then used for other shared licensing, coordinated centrally for optimal pricing

- Redistribution (more databases)

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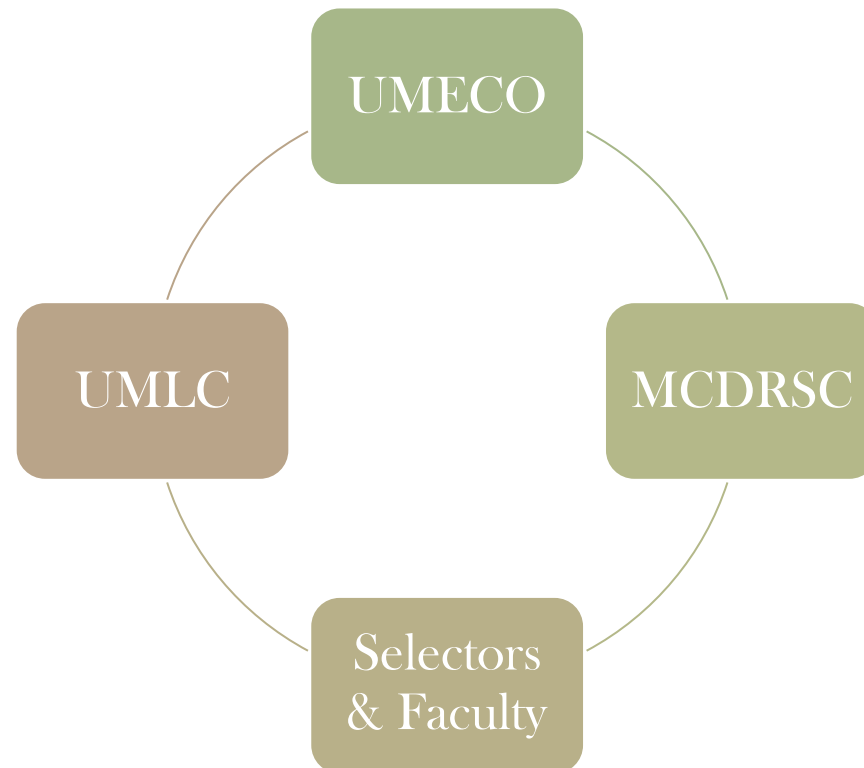
Collections Decision Changes

- Before FY23:
 - Centrally funded a large number of resources (63), with a complex system of campus voting to determine shared resources.
 - Campuses contributed funding to supplement shortage in shared funding.
- Problems with process:
 - Decision-making was a lengthy, often contentious process.
 - System funds supported resources that weren't as supportive of some campuses.
 - Campuses contributed funds to resources that weren't as supportive of their programs.

Collections Decision Changes

- Now (effective FY23):
 - Centrally funded a small number of resources (6), only those to which all four campuses can agree.
 - While it exists, budget surplus is distributed to campuses, where it is used for collections, generally leveraging relationships with other campuses.
- Benefits of process:
 - Decision-making is relatively quick.
 - Funds are used to purchase only those resources needed by any given campus, reducing waste while still leveraging our shared purchasing power.

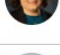




UM Collection Development and Reference Services Committee

Strategic Intentions

- Sustain meaningful and equitable access to the resources most needed at each campus within the constraints of our budget
- As we can, work together to advocate toward a more sustainable model for scholarly publication and access
 - More equitable approaches to open access author fees through transformative agreements with publishers
 - Institutional repositories for greater exposure to scholarly research and writing
 - Seeking agreement with non-profit publishers that are more supportive of faculty researchers
 - Collaboration with large consortia to develop standards around transformative publishing
 - Guidance for and collaboration with researchers to ensure they receive maximum support in their publishing decisions
