

In addition to class costs, UMKC students pay a variety of fees that fund various facilities and services on the campus. They are required of all students who have registered for on-campus courses and were established with the input and support of students and are outlined below.

Student Program/Use Fees

This cluster of four fees includes:

- The **Student Activity Fee** is capped at 12 hours, and funds student clubs and organizations as well as a variety of student activities and services. The Vice Chancellor's Advisory Committee makes recommendations regarding the allocation of these funds.
- The **Athletic Fee** is capped at 12 hours, and provides support for UMKC's men and women's intercollegiate athletic programs.
- The **Physical Facilities Fee** is capped at 12 hours, and funds student-related facilities repair and renovation.
- The **University Center Fee** is capped at 12 hours, and supports the remodeling and repair of the University Center, as well as day-to-day operating cost. With the construction of the new Student Union, funds from this fee are also used to maintain and operate that facility, as well.

Additional Fees:

- The **Swinney Rec Fee**, charged at a flat rate per semester, is pledged to retire the \$5,500,000 revenue bond issued to help with construction costs of Swinney Recreation Center.
- The **A.S.U.M Fee** is capped at 10 hours. This fee funds UMKC's participation in the Associated Students of the University of Missouri. This group advocates for student concerns at the state and national levels.
- The **Information Technology Fee** provides enhanced student computer access and capabilities on campus.
- The **Student Health Fee** is capped at 12 hours. This fee funds the Health and Wellness Center, which provides health care services to UMKC students.
- The **Student Union Fee** is capped at 12 hours, and provides payment of debt service on the new Student Union. It also supports the maintenance and daily operation of the building.
- The **Collegiate Readership Fee**, charged at a flat rate per semester, is used to support the National College Readership Program that provides copies of newspapers for students.
- The **Transportation Fee**, charged at a flat rate per semester, provides an all-access transit pass to UMKC Students for Kansas City Area Transportation Authority's Metro and Max bus services. The fee also funds a shuttle service for the UMKC Volker Campus.
