<u>Approval of Minutes of the February 13th, 2020 meeting:</u> Secretary Mark Johnson asked if there were any edits to the February 13th, 2020 meeting minutes? No additional corrections were made. <u>Chancellor's Comments:</u> Provost Agrawal had another meeting this morning and so Interim Provost Lundgren took his place. We anticipate a financial impact of decisions that will need to be made, such as study abroad, travel, etc. Updates are coming almost hourly. Meetings with Deans are ongoing about the impact on their finances. Dean Glesner Fines mentioned a big hit in CLE programs, but may get more online CLE. The Provost encourage everyone to plan for more online courses, especially planning ahead for summer. Even with online teaching campus will be open, courses will be online. Meetings would continue through Zoom most likely if we get to point of closing in classroom instruction. Computer labs will be an issue to be worked out. Kelli noted we need to figure out how to deal with public access such as relates to student needs.

<u>FY20 Budget summary:</u> Karen Wilkerson presented the financials to-date. Currently we are looking positive to budget and year-to-year and trending in the right directions.

<u>FSBC Report</u>: Ali Korkmaz gave a preliminary analysis of Faculty Salary Comparisons, which demonstrated that UMKC is generally below average of both our peers and aspirational peer institutions across all faculty ranks. More analysis will be forthcoming. Mark indicated that the FSBC had reviewed this preliminary analysis and had a list of questions that Ali would address in further analysis of the data.
