

# Safety Alert from UMKC Police

## STATEMENT ON REPORTED ARMED ASSAULT

A student has reported an armed assault that occurred at approximately 8:30 p.m., Sunday, Feb. 3, near the intersection of 53<sup>rd</sup> and Harrison streets.

The male student told the University of Missouri-Kansas City Police Department that he was approached by a single individual who brandished a revolver, then struck the student twice with his fist. The assailant did not speak. The student ran home after the assault and reported it to police this morning. Police are investigating.

No detailed description of the suspect was available.
