STATEMENT ON CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

The UMKC Police Department responded to an accidental discharge of a firearm in the north building of the Oak Place Apartments at 6:54 p.m. The round struck a fire sprinkler pipe causing extensive flooding. There were no injuries. Students were briefly evacuated at that time and returned to their rooms at approximately 9:00 p.m.

The involved parties fled the building and are not in custody. No detailed description was available at the time of the call.
