At the time of Quintanilla's residency, Dr. Glenn G. Bartle was an Associate Professor of Geology. Prior to joining UKC's faculty, Dr. Bartle took a position as a geologist at a junior college in Kansas City. Residing in Kansas City allowed him to take advantage of employment opportunities during the summers in the Mid-Continent oil fields, which paid better than academia. In 1933, after completing his Ph.D. at the University of Indiana, he returned to Kansas City and became head of UKC's Science Department and Dean of Liberal Arts.

Prior to his appointment at UKC, Dr. Bartle had taught Latin and Greek at the Borden Institute in Indiana and had been a schoolteacher and superintendent as well.
