Harold Bushman was a Professor of Philosophy at UKC. He joined UKC's faculty in 1936 after studying in Germany and at the University of Chicago. After his retirement from UKC, he moved to Berkeley, CA, where he spent the rest of his life. In the school's yearbook he was described as a professor whose classes were always interesting and even humorous, and as someone who could not be beaten in a debate. He was also an associate editor of UKC's *University Review*.
