When Quintanilla painted the murals in Haag Hall, Bill Newby and his three siblings, Bob, Mack, and Katherine, were enrolled at UKC. Bill was involved in several UKC’s organizations including the Alpha Phi Omega Fraternity, the Student Council, and the Kangaroo Board of Control. Newby studied chemistry, and after graduation, he served in the army during World War II. After he was discharged, he became a research chemist and, in 1950, he joined the organic chemicals department at the DuPont Company. Additionally, he held managerial positions at the Chambers Works in Deepwater, N.J. from where he retired in 1985. In 1997, he passed away of cancer, at age seventy-three.
