Katherine Von Voigtlander was an art student during Luis Quintanilla's residency at UKC. Additionally, she was an artist whose paintings won several prizes in state fairs and art exhibitions in Missouri and Pennsylvania. She assisted Luis Quintanilla while he painted the murals in Haag Hall. At UKC, she was a member of the orchestra, the Treasure Chest, Scroll and Quill, and the National Honor Society. Katherine traveled to Mexico where she become a translator to the Otomi natives. Eventually, Katherine became an art instructor at Wilson College in Chambersburg, PA. As recently as 2021, Katherine Von Voigtlander was recognized for designing the Museum of the Alphabet in North Carolina.
