

In accordance with University of Missouri System Rules and Regulations (Ch. 200.010) all students planning to study or travel abroad with university involvement must register plans with UMKC Study Abroad & Global Engagement. Students who wish to travel to a country or region under <u>U.S. Department of State</u> or a <u>Centers for Disease Control</u> travel advisory/warning level 3 or 4, must complete this form and obtain advanced written permission from the Senior Internationalization Officer for Study Abroad & Global Engagement.

Requests will be reviewed by the International Travel Risk Assessment Committee (ITRAC), which will forward a recommendation to the Senior Internationalization Officer for Study Abroad & Global Engagement. This form initiates committee review. More information about the <u>international travel policy request and procedures</u> is available on the Study Abroad & Global Engagement website.

This form must be submitted at least six weeks prior to planned travel. Late requests cannot be guaranteed a decision prior to the proposed departure date and may result in a denied request or delayed start date for travel.
